



Psalms of Summer - Psalm 150 - Psalm 150:1-6

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Psalm 150:1-6. What three things must authentic worship be? Read John 4:24. In what ways should we worship God?
2. What does it mean for our worship to be intentional? Is it always easy to worship? How is worship a decision of the will and not based on emotions? Read Acts 16:23-26. How were Paul and Silas intentional about their worship? What was a result of their intentionality?
3. How should our worship be intensive? How can our dignity get in the way of our worship? Read Revelation 3:15-16. How does God feel about lukewarm worship? Read 2 Samuel 6:14-15, 22. How did David worship the Lord? What can we learn from him?
4. Why must our worship be infectious? Why should our worship be passionate and not passive? How is our worship a weapon?

Reflection Questions:

1. Read John 12:42-43. What kept the Pharisees from being open about their faith? What can keep us from being open about faith? How do we overcome that?
2. How would someone describe the way you praise God? Is God blessed by you? How can you begin to take your next steps as a worshipper of God?
